The new campus will open in the fall of 2012 and be built in Pembroke's downtown, near its picturesque waterfront. The building will create additional student spaces for full-time students, allow the College to expand its programming, and will be a catalyst for further economic development and the revitalization of Pembroke's historic downtown.

Capital Campaign Chair Mark Huckabone congratulated Eastway Inc. for its leadership in supporting the project. "Building a new college campus is one of the most exciting things to happen in Renfrew County in many years, and we are very pleased with the number of individuals, organizations and companies that are supporting this initiative. Eastway is to be commended for its forward thinking and its willingness to help the College achieve its goal of building a world class college campus in downtown Pembroke," says Huckabone.

Eastway has extensive experience in refurbishing all makes of buses and special equipment used in transit. The company which started in 1962 has more than 100 employees in Pembroke and Ottawa, with the majority working at the Pembroke operations. The company services customers throughout North America including several municipal transit operations.

The College's new campus project, known as Renaissance Square, is valued at \$36 million. The College has set a fundraising target of \$2.5 million and has so far secured over \$1.3 million in pledges towards it capital campaign goal.
