SYRIAN REFUGEE BURSARY APPLICATION (Refugee Education Fund)

IMPORTANT: Applications are assessed on a case-by-case basis. You will be notified by email or by telephone within 24 hours (not counting weekends).

OSAP applicants: If you are applying for Ontario Student Loan Program (OSAP), **do not** report the bursary as income on your OSAP application. Financial Aid Services will enter this information on your behalf.

Income Tax: You will receive a T4A for Income Tax purposes. Bursaries must be reported as income.

Eligibility Criteria:

- You must provide proof of your Social Insurance Number.
- You must be currently enrolled in a full-time or part-time program.
- You must be enrolled in a Certificate, Diploma or Degree program or in language training.
- You must be a Syrian Refugee.
- You must have arrived in Canada after the onset of the Syrian Refugee crisis that began in 2011 (exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case-basis).
- You must have a financial deficit.
- You must provide a letter of intent.

Instructions:

- Complete each section and answer all questions or your submission will not be considered.
- Your Social Insurance Number must be included.
- On page 1, complete the Personal Information and the Marital Status sections.
- On page 2, complete the Study Period and the Resources sections.
- On page 3, complete the Expenses section, the Financial Need section and sign the Student Declaration.
- On page 4, provide us with a letter of intent explaining:
 Why you chose this program of study? What are your career goals and aspirations? What is your current financial situation and how this bursary will be beneficial to you.
- Submit the completed form and letter to the Financial Aid and Student Awards Office. You can leave the documents in the drop box located outside C225 or:
