Notes:

1. Full-time on-campus” activity: Three consecutive terms of 14 weeks of instruction with the Final Assessment Week scheduled for the last week. A Mid-Term Break week is scheduled week 8 of instruction in each term.
2. AC Online and Continuing Education activity: Most classes run for 14 weeks for each of the three terms. No mid-term breaks are scheduled in AC Online courses.
3. AC Online monthly intake programs and courses begin the first business day of every month and run for 14 weeks. No mid-term breaks are scheduled in AC Online courses.
4. * Grades for Continuing Education activity are due one week after the end of the course section.
5. Continuing Education refers to part-time activity that is offered mainly on-campus (not by AC Online).
6. AC Online refers to fully online programs (full-time and part-time) or online courses that are offered via the AC Online campus. There are no in-person components to AC Online programs, with the exception of field placement requirements in some courses.
